HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL TIPS TO GET YOUR CHILD READY FOR SCHOOL EVERY MORNING:

1. Set a wake-up time

You should establish a time for your children to wake up. This will enable them to prepare for school on time and finish basic tasks like brushing their teeth, putting on their uniform, and eating breakfast.
